DISTRICT CABINET OFFICERS' SCHOOLING PROGRAM

The District Cabinet Officers' Schooling was conducted from Jestha 2-4, 2082 (May 16-18, 2025) at Hotel Grande, Pokhara. The opening session was graced by International Director PMJF Lion Balkrishna Burlakoti as the chief guest, with LCIF Area Leader and IDE PMJF Lion Rajan Lamsal and GAT Area Leader PMJF Lion Khagendra Sitaula attending as special guests. CLUB OFFICERS' SCHOOLING PROGRAM

The Club Officers' Schooling Program, aimed at preparing club officers for President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer (PVST) roles, was successfully conducted in two phases this quarter. The first phase was held on June 14, 2022, targeting clubs of Clusters 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6. Cluster 2 conducted its session separately at Hotel Chulesi, Khairahani, Chitwan, while Clusters 3, 4, 5, and 6 jointly conducted the program at The Narayani Resort, Gaidakot, Riverside. The second phase, for Cluster 1 clubs, was conducted on June 17, 2022.

The schooling was organized in a role-specific format, with presidents and vice presidents attending sessions led by the District Governor PMJF Lion Nab Raj Sapkota, secretaries guided by District Cabinet Secretary PMJF Lion Dr. Ganga Sapkota, and treasurers trained by District Cabinet Treasurer MJF Lion Bikash Paudel. The program was attended by all VDGs, PDGs, and senior Lions leaders, successfully enhancing the leadership and administrative skills of club officers across the district.

DISTRICT LIONS LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE (DLLI)
